Celebrating Us is activity-based learning about citizenship ... being a good citizen in the real world and online. Each module contains student activities, plus comprehensive Teacher Notes and resources. Celebrating Us was developed by Roar Educate with teachers from the London Grid for Learning.

The pedagogy is 'constructivist', where the student learns by 'doing': by making decisions, and experimenting with choices and consequences. Activities are scaffolded, and student progress is guided by challenges, prompts and feedback.

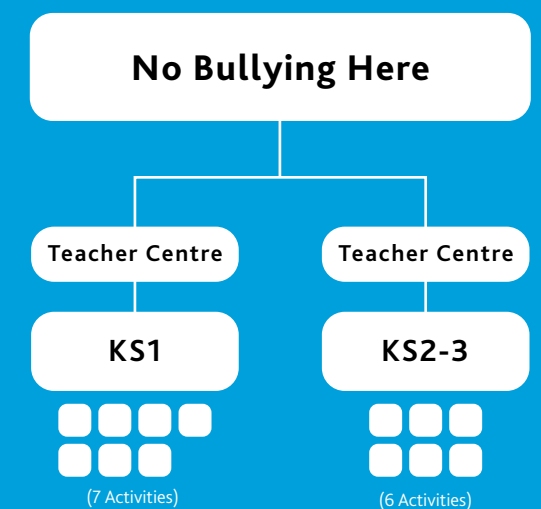

Currently in development, No Bullying Here will consist of two modules, one designed for KS1 and one for KS2/3, with 13 stand-alone activities that examine the different forms of bullying ... cyber-bullying (via the internet and mobile phones), physical and verbal bullying (inside and outside the school) and social bullying.
