

The Calebrating US Family



Who am I? Why do I live here? How might I be the same as others? And how might I be different? This module contains 20 standalone activities to explore personal identity and family background, past and future, needs and wants, and behaviours that are fair and unfair. For students at KS1.





Who am I? Where do I come from? How might others view me? How am I with people who look or act differently? This module contains 29 stand-alone activities to explore personal identity, family background, cultural diversity, stereotyping, migration and discrimination. For students at KS2 and KS3.






What are my rights? My roles and responsibilities now, and what might they be in the future? What happens when rights and responsibilities conflict? This module contains 17 discrete activities to examine the practice of good citizenship in daily life, from the personal and local to the global. For students at KS2 and KS3.







What is bullying? What do bullies do and how do they make you feel? What can you do if you, or someone you know is being bullied? Currently in development, No Bullying Here will consist of two modules, one designed for KS1 and one for KS2/3, with 13 stand-alone activities that examine the different forms of bullying ... cyber-bullying (via the internet and mobile phones), physical and verbal bullying (inside and outside the school) and social bullying.

Technical Requirements

Celebrating Us and **Us Online V2** function in all Virtual Learning Environments. All that a teacher needs is a web browser with Flash Player (version 9) that may be downloaded for free from Adobe (www.adobe.com).

Each school, LA or Grid can install the module on its own servers. Roar Educate support staff will assist in supplying the necessary technical specifications to ensure smooth delivery.

As Celebrating Us involves extensive activities and supports the sharing of student created content, issues of security are important. The modules support a Shibboleth (security authentication standard) environment if required.



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
