

Exploring Verbs - Dominoes

Purpose

This activity helps pupils become familiar with verbs in their conjugated form. It makes them think about the pronoun as well as the tense.

Objective

- ✓ To identify patterns relating to verbs
- ✓ To recognise similarities and differences

Preparation

One set of domino cards per group of 4 pupils Verb master sheet without English Verb master sheet with English Verb worksheet

Starter

In groups of 4 ask pupils to recall as many of the verbs that they met in the previous lesson as they can. Ask class to recall differences they had noticed between their verbs and the way they appeared in the story. Explain that the next activity is intended to support their understanding of these differences.

Activity 1

Give out the verb master sheet and ask pupils to complete the English column as much as they can. After 5 minutes give out master sheet with English and ask them to check their sheets. Explain that they can use the sheet to help them with the game of dominoes.

Activity 2

Groups divide the domino cards between group members. The card with the *** is placed first. Groups play dominoes using the verb master sheet for support

Activity 3 or Homework

Give out the verb worksheet and ask pupils to fill in the missing gaps. It is probably best if they tackle this together initially and then complete individually for homework.

Debrief

Discuss the activity, asking pupils what they learned, how they learned and if they enjoyed the process and if so, why.
